




JOTFORM INTEGRATION

1. Login to your JOTFORM account
2. Click "My Forms"
 - a. Click "Edit Form" on the website form you would like to integrate with the KipuCRM



3. Click "Settings"
 - a. Click "Integrations" > Search for "Webhooks"
 - b. Input the Jotform Webhook URL provided by the KipuCRM team
 - c. Click "Complete Integration"


